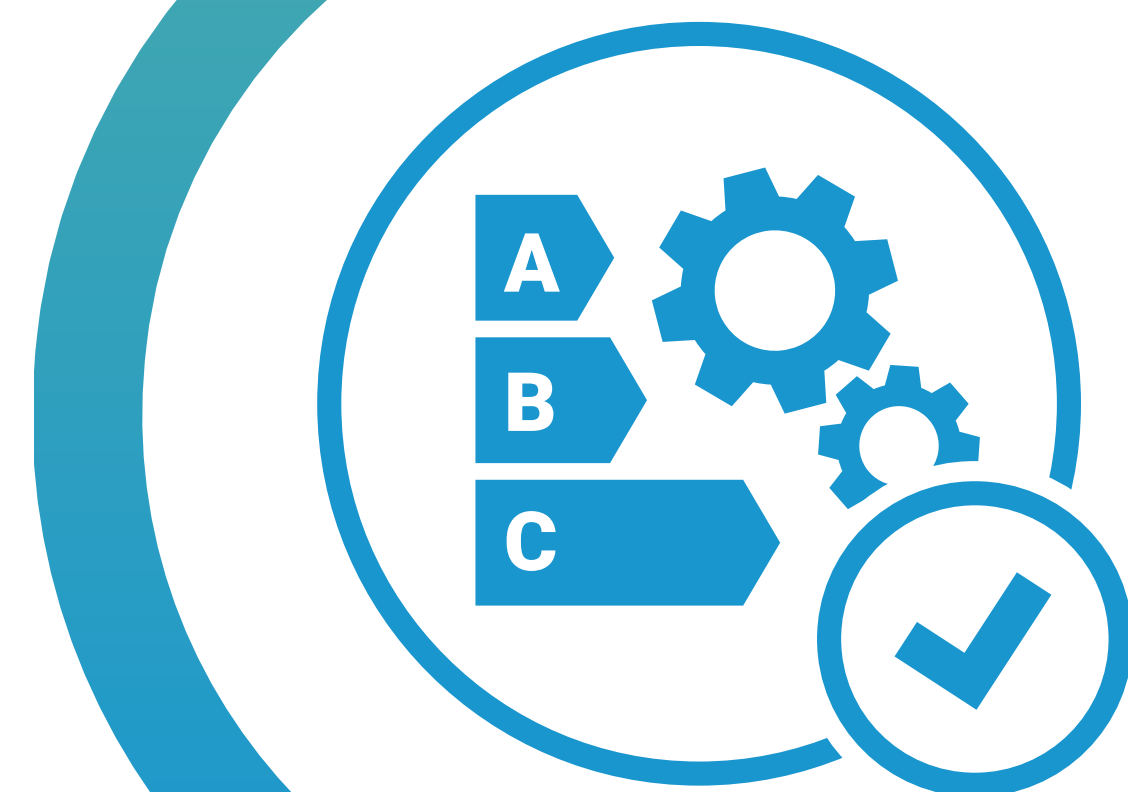

- **Criteria for pilot projects:**
 - Projects in manufacturing, assembly/installation, servicing, and SME support.
 - Submission within HFC phase-down and KIP context.
 - Government commitments on standards, coordination, and reporting.
 - Incentives to reduce controlled substance use.
 - Submission timeline, replicability, and stakeholder consultation.
- **Establishment of a \$20 million funding window for pilot projects.**
